RE: ADOPTION OF CHAPTER 82 OF THE
INSURANCE DEPARTMENT RULES

Chapter 82 of the Insurance Department Rules has now been filed with the Secretary of State for adoption.

Chapter 82 entitled, "MILITARY SALES PRACTICES" was adopted to implement Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-1534.01, passed by the Legislature as Section 7 of LB 855 in 2008, in response to the federal *Military Personnel Financial Services Protection Act*, Pub. L. No. 109-290. The Regulation, by adopting the National Association of Insurance Commissioners Model, provides appropriate standards to protect members of the Armed Forces from dishonest and predatory insurance sales practices while on a military installation. It makes actionable certain acts and practices which, until now, have not been declared to be false, misleading, deceptive, or unfair under state trade practices statutes.

The rule was filed with the Secretary of State on October 2, 2008, with an implementation date of January 1, 2009.
