

Facts About Long-Term Care

Long-term care (LTC) is a variety of services that includes medical and non-medical care to people with chronic illness or disability. Most LTC services are to assist people with support services and activities of daily living. LTC is most commonly provided in assisted living facilities (ALF) or nursing homes (NH).
