The Nebraska Department of Insurance, via it's appointed hearing officer Robert E. Harkins, conducted a public hearing on November 8, 2018, as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-2830, to consider adjusting the amount of the surcharge for the year 2019. Pursuant to § 44-2830, the Director is to adjust the amount of the surcharge provided for under § 44-2829 on January 1 of each succeeding year to maintain the Excess Liability Fund at a level which is sufficient to pay all anticipated claims for the next year and to maintain an adequate reserve for future claims. On the basis of the public hearing giving due regard to the size of the existing Fund, the number and size of potential claims against the Fund, the number of participating providers, change in the cost of living, and sound actuarial principles, I recommend to the Director, as the Administrator of the Excess Liability Fund, that he sets the surcharge for the year 2019, effective January 1, 2019, at forty-five percent (45%) for all health care providers.
