Nebraska Department of Insurance Developed an Apprentice Insurance Producer License

Lincoln, NE (December 2, 2022) – With the goal of developing Nebraska’s workforce and cutting the red tape limiting business, Governor Pete Ricketts encourages state agencies to create opportunities for Nebraska’s industries to grow. To help grow the insurance industry, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (NDOI) developed an Apprentice Insurance Producer License.

Through the Apprentice Insurance Producer License, those who want to enter the insurance industry as a producer can start with a temporary license and a mentor. Guidance document IGD - - F8 breaks down the requirements and conditions for the temporary Apprentice Insurance Producer License. Residents interested in the license can find the guidance document here and a copy of the application here.

“Through my years in the insurance industry, I found that insurance producers play an important role for the insurance buying public,” NDOI Director Eric Dunning said. “Residents lean on their local insurance producers for guidance through the complex world of insurance. Now those who want to test the waters of becoming an insurance producer can start with a mentor and a temporary license.”
