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Nebraskans Encouraged to Attend Insurance Community Discussions

September 22, 2022 (LINCOLN, NEB.) - The Nebraska Department of Insurance will be holding insurance community discussions across the state to address new developments in health insurance and hear concerns from Nebraskans.

Eric Dunning, Director of the Nebraska Department of Insurance, wants to remind Nebraskans that open enrollment for individual Affordable Care Act plans begins November 1. "The Department team will be discussing new developments in health insurance and will also address questions or concerns Nebraskans may have about any other type of insurance," said Director Dunning.

During these insurance community discussions, Nebraskans will have an opportunity to hear and ask questions about:

- Insurers offering individual market ACA coverage for 2023
- Premiums for health insurance plans
- Medicare
- Health insurance hot topics
- Common questions asked by insurance customers
- How the Department can help Nebraskans

The Department will offer two hours of free continuing education credit to insurance producers and brokers who attend the discussions.
