The Director of the Department of Insurance has scheduled a public hearing as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 84-901 to 84-920 for the proposed repeal of the following regulations:

210 Neb. Admin. Code § 53, Eligibility Requirements and Selection Criteria for Health Agencies Representative to Serve on the Board of Directors for the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool

All persons interested therein may appear at said time and be heard in reference thereto.
